Medical Careers

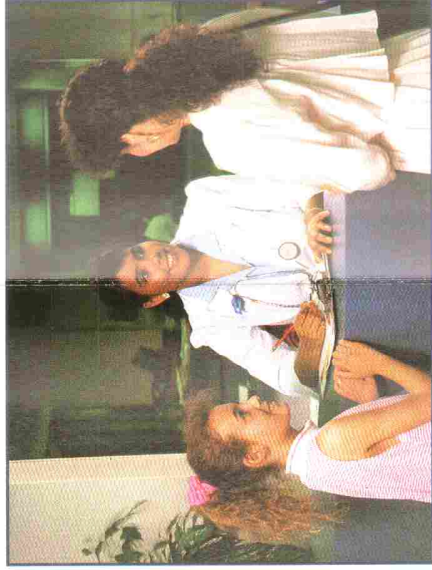
Medical Lab Technician

Paralegals work directly under the supervision of a lawyer and are often responsible for drafting legal documents, scheduling court hearings and depositions.

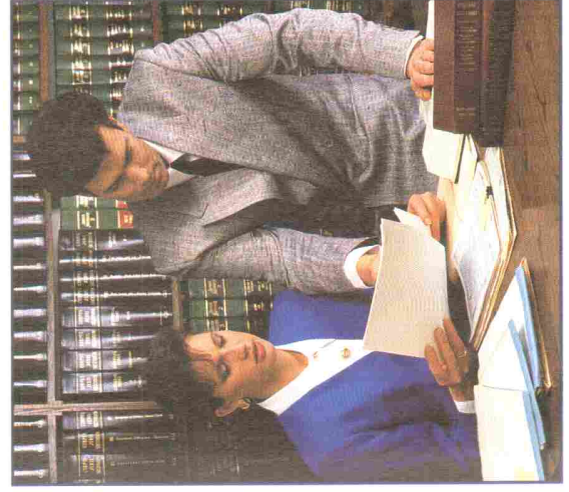
Accounting

Computer Network Administration

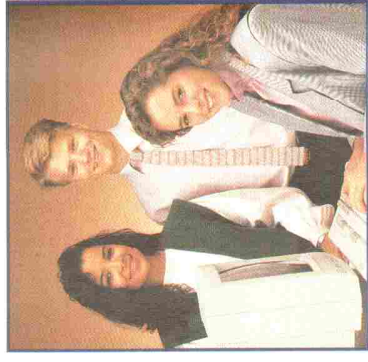

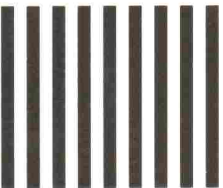
